PROCEDURE FOR VERIFYING VACUUM CHAMBERS

Vacuum Chamber

Purpose:

This method provides instructions for verifying the vacuum pressure inside a vacuum chamber.

Inspection Equipment Required:

1. Internal vacuum gauge readable to 1 mm Hg or better

Tolerance:

Equipment shall meet the tolerances specified in the applicable test method.

Procedure:

- 1. Clean the vacuum chamber of all loose debris.
- 2. Dry the inside of the vacuum chamber.
- 3. Place the internal vacuum gauge inside the chamber in a position so that the dial may be easily read from the outside of the chamber.
- 4. Apply vacuum to the chamber. Look at the dial and record the maximum vacuum pressure achieved (lowest number).
- 5. Discontinue vacuum and bleed off vacuum from chamber. Remove the gauge from the chamber.
