TRAFFIC SIGNAL MAINTENANCE WORKSHOPS

Target Audience: DOT, municipal public works, traffic signal technicians or any other government entity employees who may be called on for traffic signal maintenance. Also, recommended for division supervisors, safety officers, department safety coordinators, general trainers and/or fleet team members.

Course Description: This training includes current traffic signal terminology, traffic signal design requirements, operational maintenance, troubleshooting, preventative maintenance, and safety issues. The training also provides guidance based on the MUTCD. Basic and Advanced classes are available. The Basic class is a prerequisite to the Advanced class. Each class is 2 days in length, and to receive credit you must complete the 2-day training for each class.
