NEW COURSE

OSHA-30 SAFETY CERTIFICATION

Target Audience: Construction, roadway, and general industry workers. Also, supervisors and workers in safety roles. This also applies to local agencies with individuals in these roles.

Course Description: OSHA-30 training promotes safe and healthful work environments by training workers to identify, predict, and avoid hazards in the workplace. The class is an in-person 4-day training course that provides general workplace safety tailored to the needs of DOT, local agencies, and government employees. There are 14 hours of mandatory training and 16 hours of electives, selected by the local agencies.
